Year 11 Students will take exams for new GCSEs, graded 9 to 1, in:

- Business
- Electronic Products
- Psychology
- Hospitality

Year 9 and 10 will take examinations in all new reformed subjects.

How does this affect my child in Year 11?

The changes to your child's grades will affect all GCSE subjects which will be based on the numeric grades 1-9 apart from Business, Electronic Products, Psychology and Hospitality which will be based on the traditional Grades A*- G. Student assessment reports will reflect the actual grades your child will receive in 2018.

How does this affect my child in Year 9 and 10?

All your child's grades will be based on the new reformed GCSEs and will be based on the numbers 1-9. Student assessment reports will reflect the actual grades your child will receive in 2019 or 2020.

How does this affect my child in Year 8 and 7?

All your child's grades will be based on the new reformed GCSEs and will be based on the numbers 1-9. Student assessment reports will reflect your child's progress towards their end of Key Stage 3 target grade.
